## • 1962 AFTER KIA TS'IUAN AND LI MING

The Conquests of the Emperor Qianlong, twelve engraved plates, each divided, training to subjects and mounted in two sections within yellow silk borders on a folding sheet, Peking (?), 1789-1790, unframed  $19^{3}/_{4} \times 34$  in. (50.2  $\times$  86cm.) twelve (12)

The engravings illustrate the Formosan campaign of 1786-1788 and were designed by the court artists Kia Ts'iuan and Li Ming. They include scenes of an audience with the Emperor, land and naval actions, and include poems dated 1789.
